In pursuit of its mission, the Four County Board of Alcohol, Drug Addiction, and Mental Health Services establishes the following priorities:

- 1. Creating a community support system for severely mentally disabled and seriously emotionally disturbed children and adolescents according to the Ohio Revised Code. Services to be funded as part of the community support system include:
 - a. outreach
 - assistance in meeting basic human needs
 - c. behavioral health care
 - d. crisis response services
 - e. employment services
 - f. personal, social, and community living skill development
 - g. housing
 - h. assistance to families
 - i. encouragement of natural support systems
 - j. client protection and advocacy
 - k. community support program
- 2. Supporting services to children based on the identified needs of children in the Four County area.
- 3. Allocating no less than \$200,000 for prevention and early intervention services designed to reduce the incidence of mental illness and alcohol/drug addiction.
- 4. Alcohol and other drug funds are to be prioritized for services to treat persons determined to be in need of services consistent with the ODMHAS Protocols.
