

1. In order to insure that new Board Members are given a meaningful orientation to their duties and responsibilities and the Board itself maintains continuity and discipline, a systematic and timely orientation program shall be provided.
2. Each year, Board members shall attend at least one in-service training session provided or approved by the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services. Such training sessions shall not be considered to be scheduled meetings of the Board.
3. Copies of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 102 and Section 2921.42 shall be given to Board members within 15 days after they begin performance of their public duties, and they shall be required to sign a document that reflects having received these statutes. This signed document shall be kept on file in the ADAMhs Board office.
